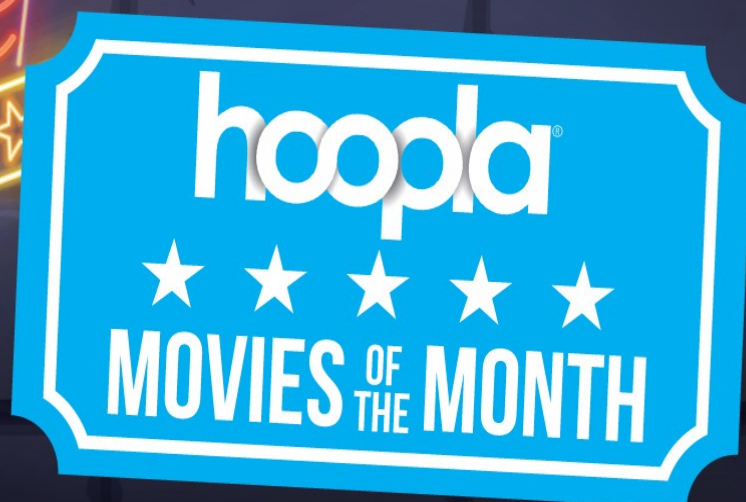
## Klara and the Sun
